Hello everyone!

Welcome to our Silver Anniversary Celebration! It is hard to believe that what started in 1996 with only 374 vehicles, mostly from the Gulf South, has blossomed 25 years later into America's Largest Block Party, Cruisin' The Coast!

We have had Cruisers come from 44 different states; the farthest away being Alaska (4,523 miles) and Hawaii (4,257 miles). Canada, Germany, Puerto Rico, France and Mexico have all been represented at CTC over the years. We even had some hot rodders from Down Under swing by for the party a few years ago.

Our very first event was 4 days long, Oct. 10-13, 1996, with only a handful of venues and events. This year, we will be 8 days long, have events in 11 cities in 3 different counties covering a 40-mile stretch of the Mississippi Gulf Coast. We have endured hurricanes, tropical storms, economic depressions, pandemics, location changes and more.

Through it all, the steady hand of our board of directors has served us well. Many of the board members who helped launch Cruisin' are still with us today. We have said goodbye to Gene and Becky, the original day-to-day leadership of CTC, who worked long days and nights in the offices as well as their kitchens and garages.

Several of our inaugural volunteers have passed and are remembered with affection and gratitude. The original Host Car Clubs were the Antique Auto and Engine Club of Mississippi, Mississippi Coast Mustang Club, Mississippi Gulf Coast Volkswagen Club and the Magnolia Model T Ford Club. When you see our "yellow shirts" out there, give them a wave. Members of local car clubs represent the thousands that have volunteered over the years to ensure a great, smooth, event. They are the pulse of CTC.

Many of our original sponsors are still with us today, and we thank them all. Patronize them if you can. They make a lot of CTC possible.

And, of course, I'd like to take a moment to thank you, our participants – The Cruisers! There have been tens of thousands of you over the years, and we appreciate and thank each and every one of you. Cruisin' The Coast wouldn't be much fun without you!

Take a look through the schedule and plan your week. You'll find several special events, great entertainment, stamping venues, celebrity appearance schedules, 25th Anniversary commemorations, electric cars, planes, and more. Please also note that we are using the same registration package pick-up schedule as we did last year. Last names A-K on Monday, Oct. 4; Last Names L-Z on Tuesday, Oct. 5. All are welcomed every day thereafter. Onsite registration will open on Monday this year!

Remember, early registration ends at midnight, **August 15**, so get that done!

## 25th Anniversary Cruisin' filled with "specials"

Probably the first thing you'll notice is that this year's participant shirt is silver (OK, it's gray!) in commemoration of the event.

The other is ... well ... a funky, fun car door donated by Sigler's Falcon Nest and is being built by Precision Paint and Body in Long Beach. You'll have to come see it for yourself, camera in hand.

Music has always been a big part of Cruisin' The Coast. How can you cruise US 90 without the radio on? We are going even bigger for the 25th! On **FANTASTIC FRIDAY**, Oct. 8, all closing acts at all seven block parties will be in celebration mode. We'll be rockin' down the highway, dancing in the streets and groovin' to the music! Check out the schedule and see for yourself. **SUPER SATURDAY, Oct. 9, our 25TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION** will be presented by Hollywood Casino and Resort in Bay St. Louis and Cruisin' The Coast. **The Legends of Motown** will put on a high-energy concert featuring the best groups to come out of Motown. We'll also have an anniversary cake and "special" fireworks to cap off the night — **ALL ABSOLUTELY FREE**. The event begins at 7 p.m. There will be limited reserved parking for registered cruisers, so get there soon.

Probably the biggest and most noticeable marker of the 25th is this year's Make-A-Wish raffle car. The silver 1957 Chevrolet Bel Air convertible was built by Woody's Hot Rodz for the 2017 Street Rodder Road Tour and crisscrossed the country that year. Belle, as we call her, was actually at the 2017 CTC event with Road Tour and made quite an impression on us. We purchased her from Motortrend Newtwork and had her shipped to South Mississippi from Hollywood. Belle's builder, Chris Sondles, will even be on hand to help in the celebration, and he is bringing a group from the American Tri-Five Association to mark the occasion.

Our friends at ET Motorgear have been working their magic on some special apparel for this year's event. Can't give too much away, but it is coooool! Oh, and look for that "special" poster commemorating 25 years of America's Largest Block Party. Check out the latest and greatest at one of their many trailers at official CTC events.
